It lives in forests, grasslands, mountains and deserts. It can climb a tree and it is a great night-time predator.


It has got beautiful fur, small paws and a hairy tail. It's brown, yellow and beige. It's a fox.

Livia


It lives in a den, inside a big cave to protect him against cold weather.
