Labradors are relatively large, with males typically weighing 29 to 41 kg (64 to 90 lb) and females 25 to 32 kg (55 to 71 lb). Labradors weighing close to or over 100 lb (45 kg) are considered obese or having a major fault under American Kennel Club standards, although some Labradors weigh significantly more.[20] The majority of the characteristics of this breed, with the exception of colour, are the result of breeding to produce a working retriever.

His coat is thick and waterproof, and its tail helps to swim. Ranging in four color between yellow and black, there are reports that the copies darker color tend to be kinder.

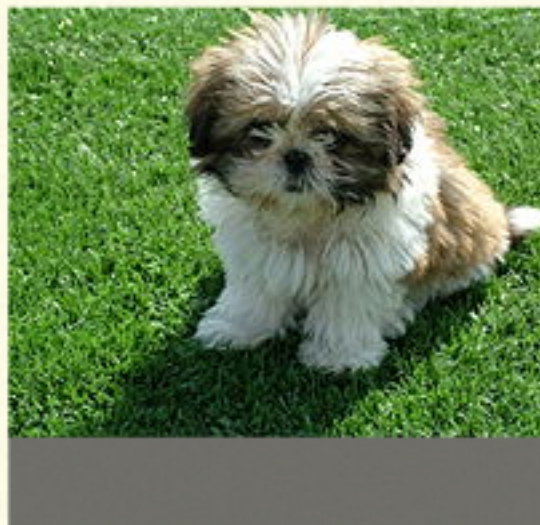

shih tzu

The Shih Tzu is small dog with a short muzzle and large dark eyes. With a soft and long double coat, it stands no more than 26.7 cm (10½ in.) at the withers and with an ideal weight of 4.5 to 7.3 kg (10 to 16 lbs). Drop ears are covered with long fur, and the heavily furred tail is carried curled over the back. The coat may be of any colour, though a blaze of white on the forehead and tip of the tail is frequently seen.



The Shih Tzu is slightly longer than tall, and dogs ideally should carry themselves "with distinctly arrogant carriage". A very noticeable feature is the underbite, which is required in the breed standard.

Shih Tzus are cheerful and outgoing. They are good lap dogs and great company to play well. They are always excited. Are attached to the family and great with children. They are very stubborn and can be difficult to educate. The Shih Tzus occupy the 70th place in the ranking of
